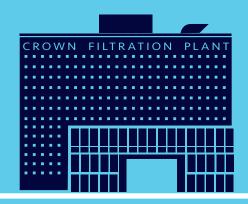

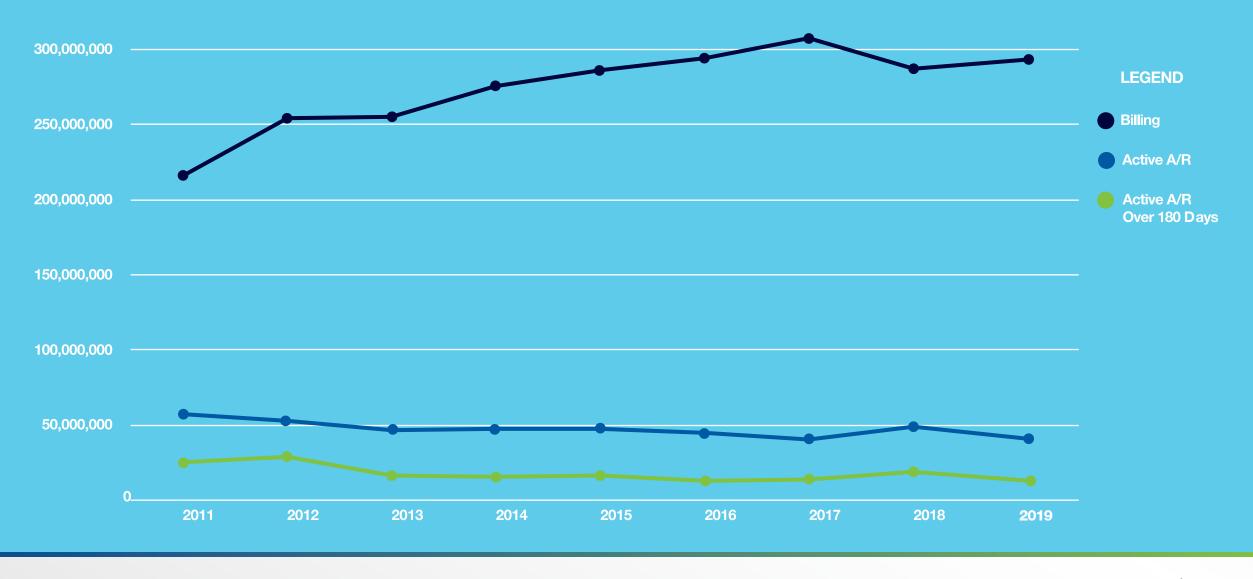

## WHERE YOUR DOLLAR GOES





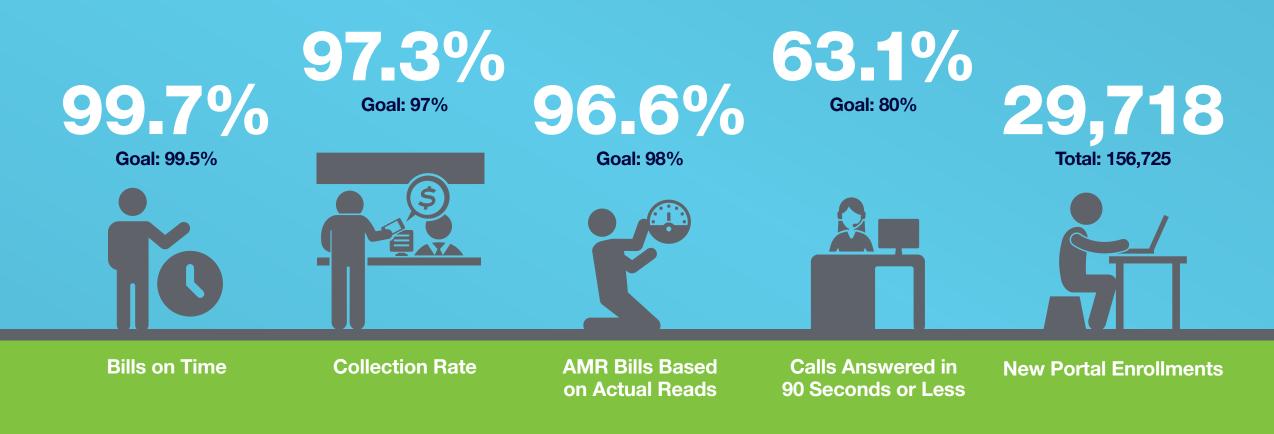
ACTIVE ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE 2011-2019

- Crown Water Treatment Plant received a Phase IV award in 2015

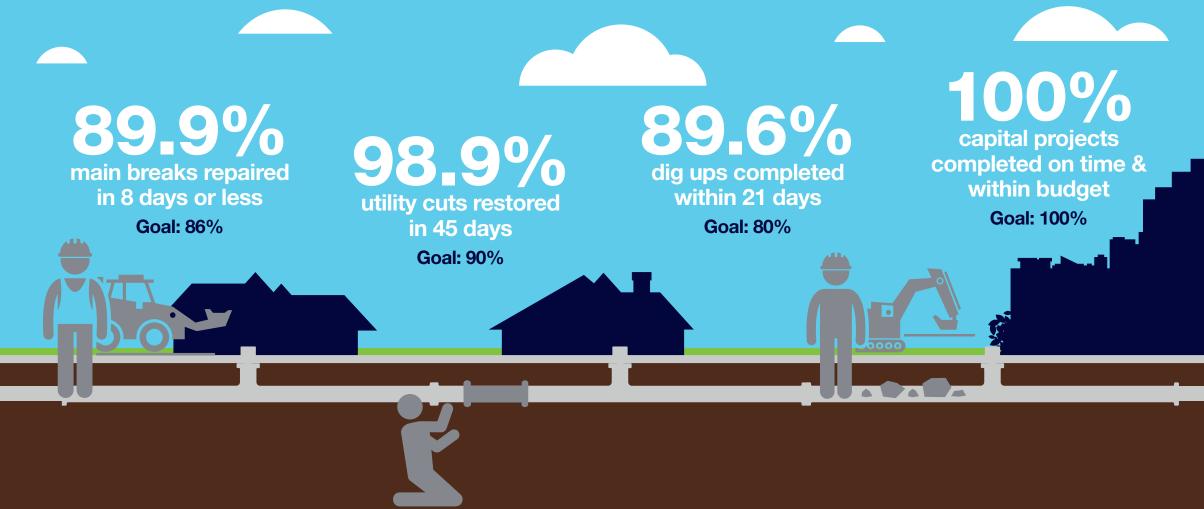
